Reception visit to Godstone Farm

As you are aware, Reception will be visiting Godstone Farm on Tuesday 28 April 2020. The outing will take place in school time and the children will be travelling by coach. For more information on Godstone Farm, please visit www.godstonefarm.co.uk

It is important that your child brings the following items to school on the day of the visit:

- A packed lunch in a lunchbox, inside a plastic bag with your child's name on it.
- A drink which will fit in the lunchbox (NOT fizzy and no glass bottles please)
- Uniform should be worn and must include a school sweatshirt or fleece and a coat with a hood, in case it rains. Trousers must be worn by all children.
- Your child must come to school in their wellingtons, with a change of shoes in a named plastic carrier bag.

There will be a teaching sessions by farm staff and a tractor ride.

The cost of this trip, to cover the above and also the coach journey, is £20.00 for each child.
